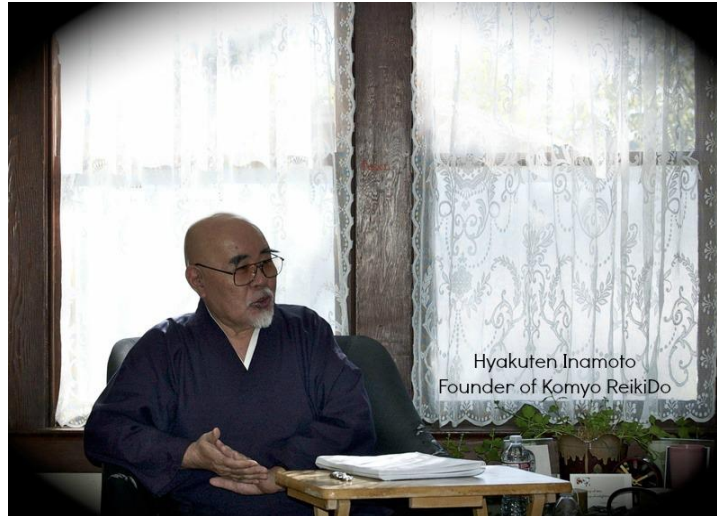

After much research into the original teachings of Usui Sensei, Hyakuten Sensei developed Komyo Reiki Kai style of Reiki in 1998. Komyo Reiki Kai follows the teachings of Usui Sensei and focuses on healing not only the body, but most importantly, the Soul or Spirit. Usui Sensei believed that with spiritual improvement, the body would naturally be better capable of healing itself.

In October 2016 Hyakuten Inamoto Sensei change the name Komyo Reiki Kai to Komyo ReikiDo.

Why the name change?

In Japanese, DO means 'a way, or a path', especially in context with a spiritual training or practice. The emphasis of Komyo Reiki teachings has always been on Reiki practice as a 'gateway to spiritual awakening leading to Satori (enlightenment)'.

Renaming the practice Komyo ReikiDo puts a greater emphasis on the spiritual aspect (practice) of Reiki Ryoho and adds clarification that Komyo ReikiDo is more than a hands-on healing art. It is a practice meant first and foremost to be a spiritual path for personal enrichment and enlightenment, with the enhanced hand-on healing ability as an outgrowth of that inner working.
