

(Hyakuten Sensei)



Internationally known as an authority on Reiki, Hyakuten Inamoto has been an invaluable consultant and translator to many authors including "Reiki: A Comprehensive Guide" by Pamila Miles, and "The Reiki Sourcebook" by Bronwen & Frans Steine.

After much research into the original teachings of Usui Sensei, Hyakuten Inamoto developed Komyo ReikiDo style of Reiki in 1998. Komyo ReikiDo follows the teachings of Usui Sensei and focuses on healing not only the body but, most importantly, the soul or spirit. Usui Sensei believed that with spiritual improvement the body would naturally be better capable of healing itself.

Komyo ReikiDo is a keep-it-simple Reiki system & practice, based on the Japanese aesthetic of Less is More. The purpose of Komyo ReikiDo is to strive for the improvement of mind & body through Reiki Ryoho practice, to cultivate a healthy & peaceful life as well as uplift our spirituality & being.

Hyakuten Sensei is fluent in English, and is noted for his kind, gentle manner, and joyous sense of humor.

Shoden June 14, 2024

Level I (Shoden). Shoden means "first or beginning teaching". The focus in the Shoden degree is primarily on self-healing, health and happiness as well as treating others. Students gain basic knowledge of Reiki Ryoho (natural healing) and its history and learn the fundamentals of the hands-on healing practice. Emphasis is placed on learning non-attachment through hands on practice and self-healing, self-improvement methods. Seminar Fee: CDN \$270.00 / US \$200.00*

Chuden June 15, 2024

Level II (Chuden). Chuden means 'middle' or 'intermediate' teaching. The focus of Chuden is on helping others through distant healing and to help the student become more aware of the concept of 'non-duality', and of their connection to the impact upon the world around them. This practice can enable the student to enhance their own energy levels and sensitivity. Three Shirushi (symbols) are given and additional Japanese techniques are taught. Seminar Fee CDN \$290.00 / US \$215.00*

Okuden June 16, 2024

Level III (Okuden). Okuden means "deeper knowledge" or "innermost". The focus of the Okuden degree is on the spiritual practice of Reiki Ryoho. It is intended for Teacher candidates and/or Reiki practitioners

who want to deepen their understanding of Reiki Ryoho and develop their inner growth. Students explore the inner teachings of Reiki Ryoho through spiritual cultivation and upliftment, and begin to tread on a spiritual path to Anshin Ritsumei (inner peace) or Satori (enlightenment)). The fourth and final Shirushi (symbol) is given along with instructions in its use and meaning. Seminar Fee CDN \$350.00 / US \$260.00*
